I extol You, my Lord and my God, and I will bless Your name forever and ever. Every day I will bless You, and I will praise Your name forever and ever. Great are you Lord, and greatly to be praised, and your greatness is unsearchable.

One generation shall praise your works to another and shall declare Your mighty acts. Lord, EPC and I want to proclaim your Gospel and shout that Jesus is Savior and Lord! We want others to know your love and grace in Jesus. We want our community to experience Jesus. We want everyone to know Jesus as Savior and Lord. Holy Spirit give us boldness to proclaim all that Jesus has done. Help us minister and share Jesus with those who are hurting, wounded, broken, and those who are hungering and thirsting for new life.

Lord you are gracious and merciful; Slow to anger and great in lovingkindness. Lord you are good to all, and your mercies are over all your works. Lord forgive us for the times we have gotten in your way and the times we have tarnished your witness.

Lord, we are desperate for revival and for gospel transformation in us and in our community. Will You by the power of your Spirit bring life and Gospel transformation to EPC and our community? We want YOU here at EPC! We want You to transform lives, and we want to take seriously the Great Commission to make disciples. Father, remove any barriers we as a church have constructed that interfere in the work of the Gospel. We surrender our agendas and our ways of doing things as a church. Forgive us where we have gotten in Your way.

We as EPC call on You to do abundantly more than all we ask and even imagine according to your power that is at work within us, to you be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.
